We are committed to:

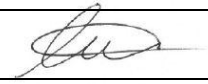
1. Regularly assess and reassess the environmental aspects and impacts of our equipment, plant, and operations to identify opportunities for improvement.
2. Comply with all relevant environmental laws, regulations, and standards related to waste management, emissions, and environmental protection.
3. Ensure that suppliers, contractors, and stakeholders understand and adhere to this policy and their respective environmental responsibilities.
4. Provide all employees with ongoing environmental training and raise awareness, actively promoting a culture of sustainability and environmental responsibility.
5. Minimise the production of waste and the consumption of water, energy and other resources through efficient use wherever possible.
6. Prevent and reduce pollution to air, land, and water by managing emissions, discharges, and waste responsibly. All waste will be disposed of under controlled conditions when recycling and/or the reuse of the materials is not an available option.

8. Minimise risk to the general public and employees from organisational operations and activities.
